\$300,000 Available for Outreach to Residents at Risk of Wildfire

The Colorado State Forest Service (CSFS) is now accepting applications for the new [Wildfire Mitigation Outreach grant program](#). Local governments, Tribal agencies or programs, and nonprofit organizations may apply for funds to support outreach among homeowners in high wildfire hazard areas.

Qualifying projects must have the primary goal of helping Coloradans understand their risk of wildfire and steps they can take to protect their lives, pets, home and property from wildfire.

Applicants are encouraged (but not required) to use [Live Wildfire Ready](#) materials in the [partner toolkit](#) as part of their project. The CSFS may be available to customize items from the campaign to meet local needs.
