He has utilized non-taxed based revenue sources to decrease the impact of Gallagher on his District and maintain financial stability. Prior to moving to Colorado, he served on the Board of Directors for the 600 member Cy-Fair Volunteer Fire Department and managed projects for Shell International Exploration & Production.
